

Talk About the Common 20th March 2009

An evening of talks about Naphill Common were given by Trevor Hussey, Neil Harris and Dr Alan Showler to an audience of 85 local residents at Naphill Village Hall - a brilliant turnout. By the end of the evening a further 20 people had joined 'Friends of Naphill Common'.
